The ***Leavenworth Society*** recognizes individuals who provide leadership support to our community through their generous donations. Established in 1987, the society is named after a prominent local citizen, Elisha Leavenworth (1841-1911), who believed that human caring was the key to a healthy society. Membership is granted to donors who make an annual gift of \$1,000 or more:

- ◆ Platinum \$5,000 - \$9,999
- ◆ Gold \$2,500 - \$4,999
- ◆ Silver \$1,500 - \$2,499
- ◆ Bronze \$1,000 - \$1,499

The ***Tocqueville Society*** was established nationally in 1984 to deepen and strengthen the understanding, commitment and support of philanthropic individuals to their local United Way. Membership is granted to leadership donors who make an annual donation of \$10,000 or more.

The ***1942 Society***, named in honor of United Way of Greater Waterbury's founding year, recognizes those who have included our United Way in their will, trust, or other estate planning documents.

The ***Loyal Contributors Society***, established in 2008, recognizes donors who have given to United Way for 10 or more years.
