

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THESE DOCUMENTS

- Valid photo ID
- Copy of last year's Federal & State returns
- Social Security #s or ITIN (Individual Taxpayer Identification) #s for you & anyone else on your tax return
- Documentation for ALL income, Social Security or pensions, including forms W-2, 1099-R, and Unemployment 1099-G
- Education expenses & student loan payments, 1098T
- Payments for child care. Bring day care provider's address and tax ID number
- Bank routing & account numbers to direct deposit your refund
- Mortgage 1098 form & receipts of property & car taxes paid
- Mortgage expenses and/or interest paid
- Access Health CT form, 1095A, only if you purchase insurance through Access Health.
- Identity theft PIN # if applicable

ONLY IF FILING FOR 2021

- Economic Impact Payment amount or Letter 6475 from IRS
- Advanced Child Tax Credit amount or Letter 6419 from IRS

IRS refunds that include tax credit payments such as the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), and the Child Tax Credit will be issued after March 1st. This include returns being processed at paid preparer locations.
